Red Group	–	Friday's


Please ensure that your child's book is kept in a clean, safe place and returned to school on the morning before they go to the media centre.

It is important to make time each day for reading to your child and also to provide time to discuss the story and pictures with your child. Encourage your child to re-tell the story to you in his/her own words if he/she so desires.
